



## AGA Virtual Meeting Code of Conduct

In registering for and/or participating in PDT 2020 you consented to comply with AGA's Code of Conduct. AGA is committed to providing a safe, productive, and welcoming environment for all meeting participants. All participants, including, but not limited to, attendees, speakers, volunteers, exhibitors, AGA staff members, service providers, and all others are expected to abide by this Virtual Programs Code of Conduct. This Policy applies to all AGA meeting-related events, including those sponsored by organizations other than AGA but held in conjunction with AGA events, on public or private platforms.

AGA has zero-tolerance for any form of discrimination or harassment, including but not limited to sexual harassment by participants or our staff at our meetings. Unacceptable Behavior is defined as:

- Harassment, intimidation, or discrimination in any form.
- Verbal abuse of any attendee, speaker, volunteer, exhibitor, AGA staff member, service provider, or other meeting guest.
- Examples of verbal abuse include, but are not limited to, verbal comments related to gender, sexual orientation, disability, physical appearance, body size, race, religion, national origin, inappropriate use of nudity and/or sexual images in public spaces or in presentations, or threatening or stalking any attendee, speaker, volunteer, exhibitor, AGA staff member, service provider, or other meeting guest.
- Disruption of presentations during sessions, in the solutions hall, or at other events organized by AGA throughout the virtual meeting. All participants must comply with the instructions of the moderator and any AGA virtual event staff.
- Presentations, postings, and messages should not contain promotional materials, special offers, job offers, product announcements, or solicitation for services. AGA reserves the right to remove such messages and potentially ban sources of those solicitations.
- Participants should not copy or take screen shots of Q&A or any chat room activity that takes place in the virtual space.

AGA reserves the right to take any action deemed necessary and appropriate, including immediate removal from the meeting without warning or refund, in response to any incident of unacceptable behavior, and AGA reserves the right to prohibit attendance at any future meeting, virtually or in person.
