Nursing Implications:

- Nurses see professional advocacy as integral to their practice and patients.
- Specific policy shapes nursing practice - some of it is helpful, and some of it AMSN is working to change.
- Nurses participate in professional advocacy at the local, state, and national levels.
- Nurses build skills and understanding necessary to becoming effective advocates.
