

THREE WAYS HEALTH CENTER BOARD MEMBERS CAN SERVE AS AMBASSADORS FOR THE COVID-19 VACCINE

Board Discussion Questions Training Handout

The short video, **Three Ways Health Center Board Members Can Serve as Ambassadors for the COVID-19 Vaccine,** outlines the following key strategies for board members:

- 1. Stay informed about where members of your community can receive the COVID-19 vaccine.
- 2. Build comfort talking about the vaccine and addressing some of the reasons members of your community may be hesitant.
- 3. Know where to point people for accurate, fact-based, and reliable information.

Health center boards are encouraged to watch the video during a board meeting and build in time for discussion of key questions to support board members in serving as ambassadors for the COVID-19 vaccine.

Board meeting discussion questions include:

- 1. What is the status of vaccine availability at our center or in our community?
- 2. What messages are most important to share in our community to build vaccine confidence?
- 3. What resources does the health center most want us to share to help build vaccine confidence?
