

FACT SHEET: President Biden Announces New Actions to Deliver Masks to Communities Hit Hard by the Pandemic

FEBRUARY 24, 2021 • STATEMENTS AND RELEASES

As part of his National Strategy to defeat COVID-19, President Biden announced a new effort to make masks more easily available to communities hard hit by the pandemic. The Administration will deliver more than 25 million masks to over 1,300 Community Health Centers across the country as well as 60,000 food pantries and soup kitchens, reaching some of the nation's most vulnerable populations.


The Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) recommends mask wearing as a critical step to help slow the spread and protect people from getting COVID-19, but many low-income Americans still lack access to this basic protection.







- Staffing, Patient Safety, Capacity, and Testing among highest percent of funded activities.
- Staffing, Minor A/R Project Delays, Limited Availability of Supplies/Equipment (Testing, PPE, etc.), and Shipping Delays are reported issues/barriers to project implementation.
- Over **600** health centers reported < 50% draw down of ECT (H8E) funds to support COVID-19 testing activities.

Awardee Expectations



- Achieve intended results/outcomes of award funding.
- Meet stated award and reporting requirements within established timelines.
- Ensure proposed/approved grant costs are allowable, allocable, and reasonable.
- Timely draw down of grant funds, consistent with the implementation of proposed/approved grant activities.
- Timely submission of complete and fully responsive reporting requirements and post-award submissions (i.e., Progress Reports, Expenditure Reports, Award-specific 30-day Conditions).
- Compliance with applicable requirements of all other federal laws, executive orders, regulations, and policies governing the Health Center Program.

Effective strategies to enhance patient safety and manage clinical risks:

- Focus on creating closed looped procedures for referral tracking, hospitalization tracking, and diagnostic tracking
- Create a RM training plan for all clinical staff
- Complete Quarterly Risk Assessments
- Involve Health Center Governing Board in risk management discussions, including sharing risk management data, trends analysis, and goals



Health Center COVID-19 Vaccine Program Overview

- HRSA and CDC partnership to directly allocate limited supply of COVID-19 vaccine
- Separate federal allocation will be deployed in coordination with jurisdictions
- Incrementally start at select HRSA-funded health centers that specialize in caring for particularly hardto-reach and disproportionately affected populations
- Initial phase increased access to vaccines to up to 250 health centers nationwide
- Beginning Phase 2 rollout 700 health centers invited




Health Center COVID-19 Vaccine Program Invited Health Centers and Sites













Heart Health UDS Measures




Served 882,986 Patients with heart disease


National Hypertension Control Initiative





HIV Care Integration

Ending the HIV Epidemic (EHE)

- Primary Care HIV Prevention (PCHP)
 Supplemental Funding FY 21
 - Approximately 175 competitive award
 - \$275,000 per year, for two years







↑ HIV testing by57% to over 2 million patients



87.21% of HIV patients were linked to care within 30 days in 2019

Workforce Health Professional Education & Training (HP-ET): Readiness to Train Assessment Update

HP-ET Goal

 To enhance health centers' capabilities to recruit, develop, and retain their workforce by exposing health and allied health professions students, trainees, and residents to education and training programs at health centers.

Readiness to Train Assessment (RTATTM) Progress as of February 28, 2021

 Approximately 8,500 individual responses from over 1000 responding health centers. This represents over 67% of health centers nationally.

Next Steps

 PCA workforce staff will use the initial RTAT results to provide T/TA to health centers to assess and improve their readiness to engage in health professional education & training, and provide T/TA to health centers to develop and implement strategic workforce plans.

- Updated Table 6A with a line for COVID-19 vaccine (removed COVID-19 vaccine question from Appendix E)

TABLE 6B

- Cervical Cancer Screening Measure: Cervical cytology was removed for women age 30 years+ (co-testing requirement removed)
- Tobacco Screening & Cessation Measure: numerator changed from within 24 months to within 12 months
- Tables 6B and 7 were updated to align with the latest CMS electronic-specified clinical quality measures (eCQMs)






Health Center COVID-19 Dashboards
