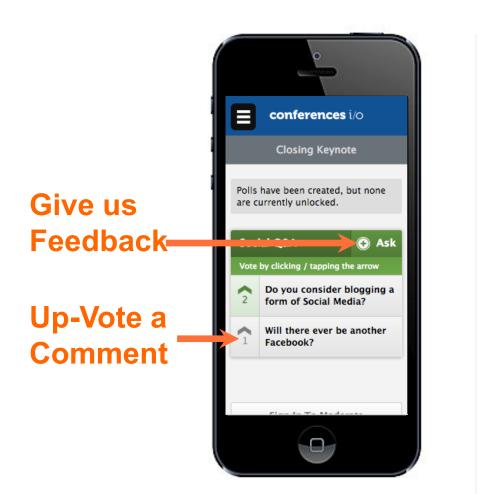



### 2021 \$BILLION CLIMATE/WEATHER DISASTERS




This map denotes the approximate location for each of the 20 separate billion-dollar weather and climate disasters that impacted the United States in 2021









